2009 RATE SHEET

Board:

Horses are fed alfalfa, oat and/or grass hay two (2) times a day. Fresh water and trace mineral salt blocks are always available. Farrier and veterinary services are separate expenses and are paid directly to the provider.	
Individual pipe pen (16x16 to 32x48)	\$325.00 / month
Group acreage	\$275.00 / month
Short term board	\$15.00 per day
“The Works”	Total care for your horse. Includes board, hoof care and paste worming. Add grooming, supplementing and turnout if desired. You write one check every month. Ask for quote.

Other services:

Turn out for penned horses	\$2 per time if regularly scheduled, else \$5 per time for fill-in
Blanketing/Unblanketing	\$60/month (daily on/off) or \$2 per time
Vet / farrier assistance (in your absence)	\$10 per time
Administration of Supplements/Medications/Grain	\$30/month (daily) or \$2 per time
Paste Worming (Ivermectin, Strongid, Panacur or similar)	\$10.00 / every other month (includes wormer)
Private Lessons	\$45.00 / hour
Horse Exercise / Train	\$30.00 per ride / hour
Horse lunge, round pen, hand-walk	\$20.00 per half hour
Arena or round pen use (outside riders)	\$10 per day or \$50 per month per rider
Grooming, bathing	\$10 per time

Outside services:

- The ranch vet is Steinbeck Country Equine Clinic out of Salinas. Any other vets need to be scheduled and attended to by owner.
- The ranch farrier is Rick Jansen from Greenfield. His 2008 rates are trim \$50, shoes \$100 and half set \$75. Corrective and specialty work costs more. Any other farriers need to be scheduled and attended to by owner.
